On January 19th, Jilly Traganou will be giving a talk at <u>Against All Odds: Ethics / Aesthetics</u>, a conference taking place at the <u>Athens School of Fine Arts</u> in Greece.

Professor Traganou's talk, "Practices of Deterritorialization Towards Post-national Imaginings: Conjoining Aesthetics and Ethics in Design," will examine the capacity of designers to cultivate postnational societies. Exploring the ethical and aesthic commitment designers have to respond to the demand for more inclusive societies, Professor Traganou will concentrate on Migratory Homes, a collaborative project which asks the vital question: "how can the disparate identities that constitute mixed societies collectively participate in the creation of a common 'home/land' that would be codesigned and co-owned?"

The conference will explore the reciprocity between ethics and aesthetics in current environmental, social, and political contexts through several disciplines, including philosophy, aesthetic theories, sociology and the sociology of professions, curatorial practices, and topology.
